







Southport Together Mental Wellbeing and Community Cohesion Small Grants Fund FAQ's

Sefton CVS has a budget of £19,500 in grant funding to support Southport based VCF sector organisations and groups to deliver a new, or additional series of, mental health and emotional wellbeing focused activities that support the priorities of the Southport Recovery Programme.

Frequently Asked Questions

When does the grant scheme open and close?

The scheme will open on Monday 6th October and close for applications on Monday 3rd November at 5pm.

How can I apply?

Please read the grant guidance here before completing your application.

How much funding can I apply for?

You can apply for a maximum of £1,500 inclusive of VAT. In exceptional circumstances the award may exceed this amount.

How do I know if my organisation is eligible to apply?

You cannot apply if you are a:

- Public sector bodies (for example NHS trusts)
- Schools
- Private sector organisation or private businesses
- Projects for residential buildings

How do I know if my project is a capital project?

A one-off purchase is considered has being capital funding not ongoing costs. We can fund things such as a six-week mindfulness class for people who don't have English as a first language. Please refer to our grant guidelines for more information.

Can I submit more than one application?

No, you can only submit one application

Can I work in partnership with another organisation?

Yes, we would be delighted to accept applications from organisations working together. One organisation will need to apply for the funding and distribute to their partner organisation.

What documents do I need to prepare for my application?

You will be required to submit all of the following documents as part of your application:

- The constitution / set of rules of your organisation
- Your organisation's latest annual accounts, or income/expenditure statement for the last 12 months
- A copy of your organisations Safeguarding Policy

What happens if some documents are missing from my application?

If you don't have all the relevant documents for your application, please contact us at communityoutreach@seftoncvs.org.uk before you apply, as you may not be eligible to apply.

What date could I start my project if I am awarded a grant?

The earliest start date would be November 2025, but this would not be confirmed until a grant offer letter is sent.

How long will I have to complete my project?

You have until the 31st March 2026 to complete the project following receipt of the grant.

What does a budget breakdown mean?

A budget breakdown should include a brief description of what you are purchasing and the cost. For example,

We need to see a list of all costs for the entire project with corresponding quotes. Any items without a quote cannot be supported.

Can I amend my application once it has been submitted?

Yes, we will accept minor changes once your application form has been submitted. If additional funding is required you should include this in your application.

How will I know if my application has been successful?

If your application is successful, you will receive a grant offer letter by email. The letter will ask you to sign a grant acceptance form and terms and conditions and return it to us before we can start to make payment arrangements. All unsuccessful applicants will be informed in writing.

Will I receive my grant payment in one lump sum or is there a payment schedule?

Yes, we will pay grants upfront once we receive a signed grant agreement.

What will happen if I don't submit my application by the deadline?

Unfortunately, we cannot accept late applications. If you are having issues submitting your application, please contact communityoutreach@seftoncvs.org.uk before the deadline.
